

Scalable and adaptable solution which can be added to and developed over time, can be scaled up to accommodate more learners and educators



Reduces administrative burden and saves time for those in teaching and practice educator roles



Encourages collaboration across training academies, sharing of excellent training materials, reduces duplication and standardises training quality



Provides streamlined learner tracking and reporting for managers and educators, plus an online portfolio of training evidence for learners

CASE STUDY



Case study: MRI Training in North West London

Challenge

- Teaching MRI sessions to Band 6 Radiographers (Rotational or Permanent) that are new to MRI or inexperienced in MRI
- Only way to teach them was face to face and in a 1:1 session


Solution

- Create self-paced learning modules on the online learning platform
- Modules can be completed at an individual's own time and pace
- Progress can now be tracked and assessed

Module	Hours saved (per participant)	Total participants/time saving
Magnetism and Resonance	3	19 / 57 hours
Essential Physics	6	17 / 102 hours
Slice, Phase and Frequency Direction	3	12 / 36 hours
Tissue Nulling	3	9 / 27 hours
MRI of the Brain	3	7 / 21 hours
	Total time saved to date	243 hours (= 30 days)

OUR REACH

User registrations

Since officially launching the learning platform on 7 May 2024 - we have over 1.7k registered users on the platform.

Certificates

There have been 400+ certificates issued for completion of our courses.

488

Self-paced learning

Through self-paced learning modules we have trained over 700 NHS staff across the Capital since launching.

Hospitals

The platform captures users from across the London region, covering 47 Trusts and Hospitals.

Live training sessions

There have been over 900 individual bookings made on our live courses, and this number is growing every day.
